Dear Sheriff Cunningham,

I am writing to inform you that the courts and judges in Bay County, Michigan are in direct violation of the liberties, rights, and freedoms of the people of Bay County, as protected by the Constitution of 1789.

It has come to my attention that the courts and judges in Bay County are operating under maritime/admiralty law, which is the law of the sea, and therefore have no jurisdiction over the people of Bay County. The people of Bay County are not subject to the statutory laws, policies, and regulations of commercial law, as outlined in the Uniform Commercial Code (UCC).

We demand that the courts and judges operating under maritime/admiralty law in Bay County immediately cease their unlawful operations and respect the liberties, rights, and freedoms of the people of Bay County, as protected by the Constitution of 1789.
