## LEGAL BASIS FOR RIGHT TO TRAVEL

- ♦ ***Murdock v. Pennsylvania, 319 U.S. 105 (1943):***

"A state may not impose a charge for the enjoyment of a right granted by the federal constitution."

- ♦ ***Crandall v. Nevada, 73 U.S. 35 (1868):***

"The right to travel freely from state to state is a fundamental constitutional right."

- ♦ ***Shapiro v. Thompson, 394 U.S. 618 (1969):***

"The constitutional right to travel from one state to another is firmly established and recognized."

- ♦ ***Kent v. Dulles, 357 U.S. 116 (1958):***

"Freedom of movement is basic in our scheme of values."

### REMINDER:

- ✓ Rights cannot be taxed, licensed, or infringed.
- ✓ Traveling privately is a RIGHT, not a government-granted privilege.
- ✓ Commerce can be regulated; private rights cannot.
